New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme.

I am directed to invite your attention towards New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme introduced by the State Government for the Government employees recruited on or after 01 January, 2006 and to say that it has been brought to the notice of the Finance Department by the Accountant General (A&E) Haryana that in many cases New Pension Scheme Contributions have wrongly been sent to Office of Accountant General (A&E) Haryana as Drawing & Disbursing Officers have not booked the same correctly in the salary bills. This type of misclassification has led to employer's and employee contribution of many employees not being sent to the trustee bank.

In view of above, you are requested to direct the Drawing & Disbursing Officers under your control to carry out a detailed exercise of verification of credits in the accounts of various NPS subscribers mapped with them. Necessary information about misclassification can be collected from the office of Accountant General (A&E) Haryana. Further details of missing credits can be ascertained by them on basis of the NPS Schedules available in their office or the Drawing & Disbursing Officers can approach the concerned treasury office to get the details of missing credits in relation to the subscribers mapped with them. In case, NPS deduction has already been done, then DDOs should approach the concerned Treasury Officer alongwith the copy of relevant schedule and voucher number of related pay bill so that contribution can be sent to the Trustee Bank. In case the deduction has not been made then arrears of such pending deduction need

to be worked out and Drawing & Disbursing Officer should start sending these contribution in installments with immediate effect.

 The above instructions may please be brought to the notice of all concerned officials/officers for strict compliance.
