Subject: Honorarium Scheme for Educated Youth in lieu of 100 hours of work per month.

As we are aware, in comparison to other States in the Country, our State is showcasing excellent growth in spheres such as Social & Access Infrastructure, Information Technology & Communications, Industrial & Realty, Human Resource Development, e-Governance, etc.


To keep momentum of developmental pace, the State Government has initiated a scheme to include the educated unemployed youth to expand the scope to support the system. This act would also inculcate the spirit of public service amongst the youth and to assist them to overcome frustration, disappointment & decline in motivation due to unemployment.

In view the above, I am directed to convey that a Scheme for post graduate unemployed youth is to be announced on 1st November, 2016 on Haryana Golden Jubilee Day celebration. This scheme envisages to provide 100 hours of work per month to the eligible youth (*as per approved terms & conditions for eligibility*), who shall work in different Departments/ Boards/ Corporations/ Registered Societies under the control of Government of Haryana for further disbursement of allowance + honorarium @ ₹ 9000/- pm. The contribution of youth may also be

by way of making them part of the drive to uplift the citizens of the State through flagship schemes of Union/State governments. The scheme would encourage these educated youth to be financially self-reliant, increasing employability for induction in employment of his aptitude and interest etc. It is reiterated to highlight that in lieu of work done by the youth, a total amount of ₹ 9000/- per month (₹ 3000/- as allowance + ₹ 6000/- as honorarium) shall be paid by Department of Employment, Haryana.

The identified/probable services are enclosed for kind reference (*Annexure -I*). However, the departments/boards/ corporations or registered societies are free to propose/suggest such service where the educated youth could be adjusted to support any given organization.

Thus, it is requested that necessary directions may be given to the departments/boards/corporations/ registered societies or subordinate offices to forward proposal to seek services of the eligible youth shall be forwarded to this department (*as per Annexure-II*), latest by 13th October, 2016 so as to enable the department to incorporate the same in the online portal, for further match making of educated youth willing to take part in the scheme.





Annexure-I

List of identified/ probable activities for assignment of educated youth under the Scheme:

- i) Disseminating of Government operated vital schemes such as 'Beti Bachaoo, Beti Padaoo', 'Swachh Bharat Mission', 'National Health Mission' etc.
- ii) Survey work such as SRDB, BPL
- iii) Remedial classes in schools.
- iv) Coaching classes for competitive exams
- v) Agriculture awareness & survey such as water conservation, minor irrigation, land testing, burning of paddy chaff in fields etc.
- vi) Sports and Yoga coaching classes in schools, colleges and village panchayats.
- vii) Old age home services
- viii) Tuitions for teaching to poor family's children at village level and urban areas.
- ix) Traffic Marshal, Home guard services/ department related work assistance.

Note:- Apart from the above referred assignment/ tasks, the respective departments/boards/corporations/registered societies are free to putforth their suggestions/ requirements so that necessary arrangements to depute educated youth could be done accordingly.
